

This scale, and Eb minor below needs a little care: they begin and end in the middle of a "Group of Three" pattern and reach the top also in the middle of a "Group of Three" pattern. When starting with these scales it is no bad idea to play every single note above, including the small notes. Then delete the topmost small notes and tie together the two chords either side of them. At the end, miss the last small notes.







LESSON 5 - Group 3 scales - neither on the syllabus, a serious omission by the ABRSM

In these two scales it is important to know the following: When one hand is playing "tibbar" (3-4), the other is playing "pincers (2-1).
